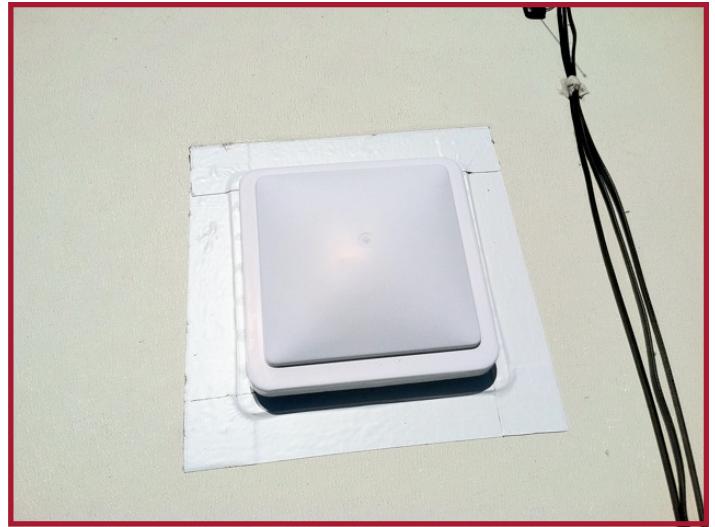

Replace Your Caulk with EternaBond



As you may know, water leaks are your **RV's** greatest enemy. Untreated leaks cause mold, mildew, stains and dry rot. That's why **Teton Homes** service personnel used to recommend checking all caulked areas at least annually, replacing caulk as needed. This inspection and replacement of caulk is not always easy. Some caulk looks good but can still leak from a poor seal underneath. Some caulk is so dirty and cracked, it's hard to tell its condition. And worst of all, after all the old caulk has been removed and replaced, within a couple years it can be time to start replacing it all over again.

Enter **EternaBond** micro sealant tape, a different way to think about roof repairs and re-caulking. A tape-like product, **EternaBond** comes in rolls and can even be applied over old caulk (although I don't recommend it). It comes with a 25 year warranty and will outlast many roof caulking projects. Application is less messy with less cleanup than caulk. **EternaBond** can be used with any **RV** roof surface. Just clean the surface, cut the pieces with scissors, peel the backing, stick it down, rub it on, and you're done.



Application:

1. To get a professional looking (and lasting) job requires preparation and the right tools. I removed all caulk around the vents, skylight and end caps with a small ½ inch wide plastic caulk remover (handed out by **Teton Homes** at rallies).
2. The surface is then cleaned with a solvent. Some use lacquer thinner. I prefer acetone.
3. While all the screws are uncovered, check to see if they are still tight, and look for signs of water infiltration.
4. Unroll strips of **EternaBond** and cut them to length. It cuts easily with scissors.
5. Peel back a few inches of the plastic backing and **CAREFULLY** put the strip in place by pulling off the backing sheet as you press the **EternaBond** into place. Once the **EternaBond** touches the roof surface, it begins bonding, especially if you put any pressure on it.
6. Use a small roller to press the **EternaBond** firmly to the roof surface. I used a wallpaper seam roller, but small heavier rollers are available from some building supply houses. As you press the product into place, try to minimize all air bubbles and corner "tenting." Overlap all edges.

Where to go after Myrtle Beach



If you have some extra time after the rally in Myrtle Beach, come on down to James Island County Park in Charleston, SC for the Holiday Festival of Lights .

For the last 22 years, the Charleston County Park and Recreation Commission has hosted the Holiday Festival of Lights. Open from mid November through December, the light show - described as *"a three-mile drive through hundreds of breathtaking light displays featuring millions of twinkling bulbs"* - is a treat with over 600 displays. Replace Your Caulk with EternaBond

Tips:

1. **EternaBond** is not a friction activated tape, so don't try to stretch it. Actually, that will decrease its adhesion factor.
2. When the tape is put in place, roll/rub it aggressively to activate and form a strong bond.
3. If you have any air bubbles larger than a quarter, pierce or cut the bubble and squeeze the air out. The **EternaBond** will seal the opening as it is pressed into place.
4. Minimize "tenting" on corners, edges and between surface levels. If necessary, the tented area that is not in contact with a surface, can be cut and pressed down. A second, smaller piece, can then be placed over top of the cut section.
5. To keep a clean edge on the **EternaBond** that will be facing into the wind, run a bead of caulking of sealant along that edge.



Lifting of an edge can occur if the roof surface was not properly cleaned. If this happens, try re-activating the tape by heating it with a hair dryer or heat gun, then re-press it into place. If it still won't hold, cut out that area, re-clean the surface (especially remove any silicone) and press a new patch into place.

After checking around and reading the internet posts of other RVers, I purchased my roll of **EternaBond** from **Best Materials** discount warehouse (<http://www.bestmaterials.com>). The product I selected is **RSW-4-50**. This is **EternaBond Roofseal White** faced 4"x 50 foot roll. Note: This is a full 50' roll not the 37' roll many others offer. List price is **\$85.00** but is often for sale at **\$55.75**.

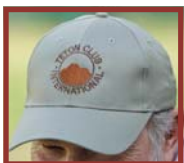
